I'm excited to share with you the annual report on graduate education and research activities for Fiscal Year 2024. This year, our university has achieved a remarkable milestone, with total research expenditures reaching a record \$1.3 billion—an 8% increase over the previous year. Our college contributed to this success, with a total of \$87.5 million in research expenditures, representing a greater percentage increase than the Penn State average.

Many of our research programs rank in the top 12 in the National Science Foundation rankings for Higher Education Research and Development expenditures across key fields and subfields in science and engineering. We also continue to maintain stellar nationally ranked educational programs, as reflected in the U.S. News and World Report's rankings of "Best Graduate Schools"

In addition, our proposal and award activity showed a substantial 23% increase from the previous fiscal year. This significant growth allows us to project a very healthy and continuous research activity in the coming years, strengthening our position in driving forward innovation and discovery. These achievements are a testament to the dedication, collaboration, and hard work of our researchers and staff across the college.

As we continue to build on this momentum, I look forward to seeing the impact of our efforts in the years ahead,




Graduate Student Enrollment, 2014-2024


Graduate Enrollment by Campus and Credential

Graduate Enrollment by Campus and Department






